- Travel voucher of CHF 1000 to attend an international conference
- Invitation to present the research in the laureates' issue of CHIMIA. Value CHF 1'200.

Prize for the Runners-up

- Cash contribution of CHF 400.

### **Best Poster Presentation Award**

- Invitation to present the research in the laureates' issue of CHIMIA. Value CHF 1'200.
